Customized background checks on potential foreign business partners. The ICP report includes quantitative and qualitative info on the target company's:

- Competitors
- Credit rating
- Profit and loss numbers
- Key officers
- Commercial Service opinion on the viability of the firm



Advocacy Center

The Advocacy Center ensures that sales of U.S. products and services have the best possible prospects abroad. Assistance may include:

- Visits to key foreign officials by high-ranking U.S. officials
- Direct support from U.S. officials stationed overseas
- Letters to foreign decision-makers
- U.S. export credit agency financing support
